<b>Who is at risk?</b>	Singers asked for online BACS payments rather than cash.(3)	Singers
All. More so if over 70, or clinically	Singers encouraged to socially distance (2).	Singers
<b>RISK Minimisation Strategy</b>	Singers asked to bring their own refreshments and take comfort break when they need to (3)	Singers
1. Increase Ventilation	Singers instructed to bring warm layers (1).	Singers
2. Maintain Social Distancing	Singers asked to socialise after choir has ended, outside the building (1).	Singers
3. Reduce Spread via Surfaces	Singers asked to take self responsibility for coming to choir (2)	Singers
isolation if required	Singers asked to wipe down chairs at the end of the session (3).	Singers
5. Reduce length of potential exposure	Singers asked to inform choir leader if they contract coronavirus anytime after the session (4).	Singers
	<b>Venue:</b>	Venue/caretaker
	Chairs spaced out(2).	
	Caretaker will wipe down door handles, toilets etc before and after the session (3).	Venue/caretaker
	More ventilation: caretaker will open roof windows and fire door (1).	Venue/caretaker
	Rehearsal time shortened (5) .	choir leader
	<b>Choir leader</b> will send word sheets in advance for people to print out and bring (3).	choir leader
	Choir leader will keep a record of who attends each session (4).	choir leader
